DAY 6 THE SEED OF LOVE



1. SOW THE SEED

I John 4:16 NLT

We know how much God loves us, and we have put our trust in his love. God is love, and all who live in love live in God, and God lives in them.

Our trust in God expands when we have the confidence to trust in his love. If we turn the first sentence in the verse into two questions, ask yourself:

- 1. Do I know how much God loves me? If you answer YES, how do you know? If you answer NO, why not?
- 2. Have I put my trust in his love? If not, what is holding you back?



2. REST IN THE SOIL

Repeat these words as you meditate: *God is love, and all who live in love live in God.* Emphasize a different word each time you repeat it to gain another perspective.

3. PRAY

Yahweh (Jehovah) you are the Almighty Creator and Redeemer. Only through the death of my daughter can I gain a small understanding of your love for me. I cannot imagine willingly sacrificing my only child for anyone. But you did, and that sacrifice is my salvation. Your love is amazing!

THINKING

Consider God's greatness. How is it possible for Him to love each person in the world each day? Read Job 38 to be reminded of God's immense power.

DOING

Can you earn His love?

The "Doing" step today is NOTHING while you remember how God loves you. Tell Him how you understand this huge idea.

4c. FEELING

Feeling God's love will require some work. It isn't an automatic result of knowing God loves you.

He is waiting for us to invite Him in. He wants a relationship with His children.

Read Psalm 40 to see what David said about waiting and then how the Lord responded and then David's response. Write your feelings here.

1. SOW THE SEED

JOHN 15: 9, 10

DAY 10 THE SEED OF LOVING EACH OTHER



1. SOW THE SEED

I THESSALONIANS 3:12 NIV

May the LORD make your love increase and overflow for each other and for everyone else, just as ours does for you.

The second commandment (after "Love the Lord your God" is "love your neighbor as yourself. In Paul's letters to young Christians in the New Testament he always encouraged them to love each other. In 1 Thessalonians he acknowledged their love for each other in chapter one, but in chapter three he urges them to <u>increase</u> their love and then let it spread beyond their body of believers.

These believers faced cruel persecution from the influential Jews as well as Roman citizens. How could loving each other help through hard days? Imagine yourself in their situation. What would you need?

How can loving others help you through your grief or loss?



2. REST IN THE SOIL

Meditate on: Make my love increase for others.

3. PRAY

Father, sometimes the last thing I can or want to do is love others. My pain can be so deep that I withdraw into myself. I know you can increase my love for those near me. Add your own prayer.

THINKING

Today's verse is in the middle of a prayer from Paul in behalf of the persecuted believers in Thessalonica. He asks God to make their *agape* increase for each other. *Agape* is a type of love unique to the Christian point of view. It comes not from emotions, but from choices, requiring faithfulness, commitment, and sacrifice without expecting anything in return. How is this different from brotherly love?

DOING

Paul asks these Christians to love each other and everyone else. What can you do today that would express *agape* love to someone?

FEELING

Since *agape* love is NOT about feelings, how can you move your emotional self to express love that is sacrificial, selfless, and unconditional? Do your emotions get in the way of being selfless to someone who seems unlovable?

Can you change those feelings? How?

Ask for the Spirit to show you how or when to love others unconditionally.
